FINANCIAL

- The FOR Club has some income from APEX.

- The board officials signed with online platform, Give Smart.

- There are other incoming funds from things like Amazon Smile, Green Flash Pest Control for people who sign up and mention FOR Club or Richland. Heidi to schedule recurring FB posts for GFPC special once a month.

APEX

- Profit is currently at 10,325.

- Casey was hoping to discuss possibility for APEX virtual and live lessons to continue and service schools.

- They are inquiring for feedback as to what has been the best/worst part so far. If there were rewards how could we implement that and how would deliver them? T shirts or lanyards would definitely be good. If we did have these extra things, we would not receive 100%.

STATS:

- 6-34% of participating in class. Average class participation: 19 % of class. 16-65% of class logged on. Average school logged on: 38% 32% were parent donors whereas normal the parent donors goal is to be under 32%. 11 sates were represented in pledges.

- There was an increase of almost a third over the weekend. Historically there is a jump the day before the run but they not expecting the jump because of Chromebook drop offs.

2020/2021 PREP

- Thank you to Heidi for this year and will be doing the outreach next year.

- Funding next year will be allocated for Interventional reading, supplies, STEAM. Julie will let the board know about updates regarding any new reading program or online program to be implemented and the expenses thereof.

- Fundraising option on July 1st for cupcakes and would be a bit like a dineout. Vanessa to coordinate it. Possibly set up an eblast.

PRINCIPAL UPDATE

- Appreciate FOR Club every year. However, this year when admin thought every thing was going to shut down but the Club continued to work. They thank the board for everything.

- They do not know what things will look like next. year. The only thing they do know is that there will be an option for a 100% online program for people who want to do that. They do not know who is going to be teaching it and if it will be a grade and school or district thing.

- Garcia will be sending something out and she has a team for people who are going to be working planning all summer.

- Budget is \$56,000 less than last year. They anticipate that we will probably going to be title 1

next year.

- Cuts at state level will go into effect next year. Newsom's budget he said we are going to give cost of living of 2% to district. We will be negative 8% when they cut us 10%. The state budget will be approved June 30th is when they are going to approve the budget (state)

- Richland is moving forward with full day kinder.

- School will be starting August 18th and not earlier. A lot of districts already start in July. San Marcos elementary is doing a summer school to recoup their loss of English language learners.

- Question about rebuild. Per Julie: They have had a couple meetings. Dr. Garcia assures Richland is the next big agenda item. The team is moving forward. Meeting next few weeks. A bill will most likely not going to be able to be pitched with everything going on. Economy won't be able to pay. They have facilities that they have to use when they build. There is a pot of money they anticipate on getting back from other builds. That money for facilities would come to us first. We could begin to be phased to proceed with a rebuild. Julie has met with an architect and they are very excited and anticipate being able to meld together best of what they saw. Not an 18 month build but a 3-4 year build if there is not a bond. \$60,000,000 to rebuild a school.

TEACHER REPRESENTATIVE

- Kim Klimas is moving. Normally a new one is not appointed until 2/3 weeks into the school year.

YEARBOOK

- Yearbooks have not arrived yet and will not be there for pickup by the end of the year. Hope to get them in June.

- There is not usually a profit but last year and this year we will. If we get overruns there are going to be no more than 15 and they will be hardcover. Last year they didn't bill them for overruns. This year they may.

GOLF

- No update on the Tournament.

- Twin Oaks Golf Course is open but not doing tournaments. We can maybe do one in the fall and another one in the spring since sponsors have already paid. Waiting on cart policy and as

soon as you can have more than one person in a cart who isn't a family member we will work to move forward.

- Advertise and create a Virtual Carnival Committee sign up on the website and sign up for.
- IDEAS: Slime kits to make own slime. Prizes from last year. Virtual haunted house and costume contest.
