- There have been 2 rebuild meetings: one for Richland Families and one for communities
- June 10 is the first demo day.
- There will be an update in Eblast every week.
- Negatives: temporary: traffic and parking will be bad. back parking lot will be lost. A parent talked to church up on the hill and we could use for parking at events.
- There will be a FOR Club room! It will be near the front of school convenient for drop offs and has a door to the outside which will be good for meetings.
- Richland lost title 1 funding last week.

District Presentation: Grant for district Bill 86, ELO: San Marcos unified expanded learning opportunities. One time, 1 year only to help with recouping instruction. To help with food, instruction, social emotional funding.

- Requirements to receive this: School must have summer school opportunities, has to have after and before school opportunities and supplemental learning in the school day.
- Priority groups, english learner homeless, foster, and socioeconomic disadvantaged home.
- All students will be invited based on academic needs based on data.

- At Richland for the summer they are addressing: english learning, arts and math.

2021-2022 school year. Supplemental learning during school day will be: tier 1; core universal instruction, tier 2; targeted instruction for those who need it and tier 3; intensive instruction as needed.

- Social Emotional Learning supports; the counselor will be full time.

- Specialized professional development: students are lacking in math specifically: teachers need more instruction: EL, culturally response practices, trauma informed care, restorative justice, Positive Behavioral Intervention Supports, how to help those that excel as well.

- K-12 site based programs: language arts and math.

- Richland: June 14th - June 25th 8:30-11:45 kinder - 5th; detective camp. Math and Reading investigations. Centered around covid theme.

- Kinder boot camp: limited preschool experiencing because of pandemic. August 2nd- August 6th : 8:30 - 11:30. Invitations will go out soon.

- Techie camp: virtual STEM: 5th-8th. Virtual summer soar: ASES funding. VAPA integration, English language and invitations have gone out.

Teacher Appreciation:

Sailing On:

- We will be able to have promotion for 5th graders!

- There are 127 kids for signs.
