- Good news; 3rd, 4th and 5th: testing has been waived by the district. They were given the option to use an alternative assessment and they took it. iReady will be used instead of state standardized testing.

- Not so good news: orange: playground was assessed and assessor came and deemed it unsafe, on account of the facility not due to COVID. Kindergarten playground is unsafe as well but can fix it since it will last for a year and a half while upper grade playground will be demolished in June. Can FOR Club fund any equipment?

- Teacher and staff of the year. teacher is Kristen Sepich: Reesa Williamson is staff of the year. Has not been announced outside of school. Some parents sent in recommendation letters.

- Federal and State want to make up for learning this year. A \$10,000,000 grant will be awarded to the district if they are able to do certain things. Summer school, after school next year and within school. Options: School board wants to do summer school for all. Richland is doing summer school for ELL, one for academic needed. another is an enrichment. This will be outsourced but funded by district. LEAP is parent funded.

- School is working on plans to do an in person promotion. it looks like it can happen.
